

Kurt von Bley // 'Landscapes Without You'

Parting, absence, loss, separation, change, death, grief - these borderline phenomena are the main focus of Kurt von Bley's mostly new and never publicly presented works in his solo exhibition in the R52L art space in Charlottenburg.

The exhibition bears the seemingly poetic title "Landscapes Without You" and exclusively includes black and white sculptural, installation and photographic works.

These oscillate between minimalist coolness and precision on the one hand and an intimately revealed vulnerability on the other.

The aestheticization of what is generally perceived as negative runs through the artist's eerily beautiful oeuvre like a common, in this case, black and white thread.

Kurt von Bley, born in 1976 in Königshütte/O.S. (Chorzów), Poland, resides and works in Berlin.
